PHONICS COMPETITION

Levels:

- **Junior: Age 4–7 years**
- **Senior: Age 8–10 years**

Topics / Rounds:

- 1. Sound Recognition (a-z, digraphs, blends)**
- 2. Word Building**
- 3. Reading Fluency**
- 4. Spelling & Pronunciation**

Rules & Regulations:

- 1. Participants will be given word lists or tasks on the spot.**
- 2. Time limit: 3–5 minutes per round.**
- 3. Pronunciation and clarity are mandatory.**
- 4. Reading passages or picture cards may be used.**
- 5. Evaluation Criteria:**

Double-digit with carry/borrow

3-digit addition/subtraction

Speed test

Example: $154 + 231 - 122$

Duration: 15–20 minutes

GRADE 4

4-digit addition/subtraction

Introduction to multiplication (2×1 digits)

Example: 23×2

Duration: 20 minutes

GRADE 5

2-digit \times 2-digit multiplication

Simple division (2-digit \div 1-digit)

Example: 24×13 , $84 \div 4$

Duration: 20–25 minutes

GRADE 6

Mixed operations (+, −, \times , \div)

Large numbers up to 5 digits

Example: $123 + 456 - 32 \times 2$

Duration: 20–25 minutes

GRADE 7

Mental math visualization (without abacus)

3-digit \div 2-digit

Introduction to decimals

Example: $864 \div 12$, $5.4 + 2.3$

Duration: 25 minutes

GRADE 8

Advanced mixed operations

Decimal calculations

Rapid flash test

Example: $12.4 \times 3 + 45 \div 9$

Duration: 25–30 minutes

GRADE 9 (Grand Master Level)

Complex multi-step problems

Mental calculation rounds

Speed and accuracy test

Listening round

Example: $234 \times 23 \div 9 + 56 - 17$

Duration: 30 minutes

VEDIC MATHS COMPETITION TOPICS – GRADE 1 TO 4

GRADE 1 (Beginner Level)

Number recognition (1–100)

Forward and backward counting

Basic addition and subtraction

Number bonds (making 10)

Introduction to patterns and sequences

Time Duration: 10–15 minutes

GRADE 2 (Foundation Level)

Double-digit addition and subtraction

Tables up to 10

Introduction to Vedic tricks for quick addition

(Example: $9 + 6 \rightarrow$ Add 10 and subtract 1)

Number complements (Pairs that make 10 or 100)

Simple mental subtraction using “By 10 less”

Speed round – 10 quick sums in 2 minutes

Time Duration: 15 minutes

GRADE 3 (Intermediate Level)

2-digit \times 1-digit multiplication using Vedic sutras

(e.g., “Ekadhikena Purvena” – one more than the previous)

Quick subtraction using “All from 9 and the last from 10”

Doubling and halving numbers

Finding squares of numbers ending with 5

(e.g., $25^2 = 625$, $35^2 = 1225$)

Magic patterns and number puzzles

Time Duration: 20 minutes

GRADE 4 (Advanced Beginner Level)

2-digit \times 2-digit multiplication using Vedic method (Vertically & Crosswise)

Division by single-digit using Vedic trick

Multiplication by 11 shortcut (e.g., $45 \times 11 = 495$)

Squares and square patterns (up to 30^2)

Mental arithmetic practice – rapid round

Application-based problems (money, time, distance)

Time Duration: 25 minutes

Rubix Cube

Competition Categories / Topics

Junior Level (Age 6 – 12 years)

2×2 Cube – Solve the 2×2 cube as fast as possible

3×3 Cube – Solve the standard 3×3 cube within the time limit

Senior Level (Age 13 – 18 years)

3×3 Cube – Speed solve using any method (Layer by Layer, CFOP, etc.)

4×4 or Mirror Cube – Advanced solving round (optional for experienced solvers)

Open Category (All Ages)

♦ **Pattern Creation – Create a specific color pattern (e.g., checkerboard, cross, stripe) within the time limit**

Rules and Regulations

Eligibility: Open to all students under the defined age categories.

Cube Type: Participants must use their own cube (no magnets, lubrication allowed).

Inspection Time: 15 seconds of inspection before starting the solve.

Solve Time Limit:

Junior: 2 minutes (2×2 or 3×3)

Senior: 1 minute 30 seconds (3×3 or higher)

Solving Method: Any method (Layer by Layer, CFOP, Roux, etc.) is permitted.

Timer: Official stopwatch or digital timer must be used.

Disqualification:

If cube pieces pop out and are reassembled during solving.

If cube is not fully solved when time stops.

Judging:

Best of 3 rounds.

The fastest solve time will be considered.

Tie Breaker: Shortest average time or accuracy of pattern formation.

Final Round: Top 3 from each category will qualify for the Grand Finale.

The time limit for the competition is 20–30 minutes.

Only one entry per participant is allowed.

No rough work or rewriting is permitted; only one final sheet will be evaluated.

The handwriting must be neat, legible, and properly aligned.

Capital letters or cursive writing may be used depending on the age group and category rules.

Use of sketch pens, markers, or coloured pens is not allowed unless specified.

Junior Level: 6–10 years

Senior Level: 11–16 years

2. Drawing Time Limit: 1 hour (60 minutes)

3. Paper Size: A3 or A4 sheet (provided by participant or organizer as per event)

4. Mediums Allowed:

Crayons, Color pencils, Watercolors, or Poster colors

Sketch pens allowed for outline only

5. Original Work:

Drawings must be original and created on the spot.

Tracing, digital art, or printed outlines are strictly not allowed.

6. Identification:

Participant's name, age, and registration number must be written on the back side of the drawing sheet.

Handwriting (Tamil & English)

General Rules (Applicable to All Levels):

Writing paper will be provided by the organizer.

Pen/pencil as per level:

Junior: Pencil only

Senior: Blue/black pen

Time Limit:

Junior: 15 minutes

Senior: 20 minutes

No erasing or rewriting allowed once time starts.

Judge's decision will be final.

All participants will receive Certificates, Medals, and Trophies for excellence.
